Information gathered for YPI and its programs

Goypi.org gathers information to better serve its visitors and registered users.

We collect various kinds of data from visitors including:

- How long you visited the site
- Which pages you visited
- What links you clicked on
- Other relevant traffic information that serves the needs of goypi.org and its visitors and registered users.

We also collect additional information from registered users. These are users that have voluntarily given goypi.org **Personal Identifiable Information** such as:

- E-mail addresses, for e-mail newsletters and program updates
- Contact details and information
- Names and phone numbers

We use cookies to obtain information about the preferences of our visitors and users.

Why we have members register

Goypi.org requires registration on the site to access a variety of content available to our registered users. Registered Users have **transactional privileges to:**

- Access study guides and lesson plans in .pdf format
- Access multimedia content for YPI
- Access support materials for final presentations

Goypi.org will also send out e-blasts and e-newsletters from time to time to registered users. Relevant content and additional information about YPI is often the subject of these e-blasts.

Personal Identifiable Information and how goypi.org uses that information

Personally Identifiable Information refers to any information that identifies or can be used to identify, a registered user or a visitor including, but not limited to, name, address, phone number, fax number, and email address. Personally Identifiable Information does not include information that is collected anonymously or demographic information not connected to a particular user.

In addition to our direct collection of information, our third party service vendors may collect information from our Visitors and Authorized Users. We may share aggregated information about our Visitors, including the demographics of our Visitors and Authorized Users, with our affiliated agencies and third party vendors. We also offer the opportunity to "opt out" of receiving information or being contacted by us or by any agency acting on our behalf. Details are at the bottom of this document.

Personally Identifiable Information collected by goypi.org is securely stored and is not accessible to third parties or employees of goypi.org except to distribute user requested data.

We will never rent or sell your information to a third party. We use Personally Identifiable Information to customize the Site, to make appropriate service offerings, and to fulfill transactions on the Site.

E-mail policy

From time to time, goypi.org will e-mail registered users with newsletters or information regarding YPI. We adhere to Canadian and American standards in e-mail spam compliance. We only send out relevant information to users who have registered with us. Opt-out options are provided in our e-blasts and on our website.

Removing or Changing Personal Information

Visitors and Authorized Users may update their contact information or to be removed from our lists by emailing us at info@toskanfoundation.org.

Authorized Users have the option to remove Personally Identifiable Information from goypi.org's database by contacting info@toskanfoundation.org. An individual who requests to have Personally Identifiable Information removed will have this information deleted, and we will not transfer or use Personally Identifiable Information relating to that individual.
